BEACH CLEAN-UP

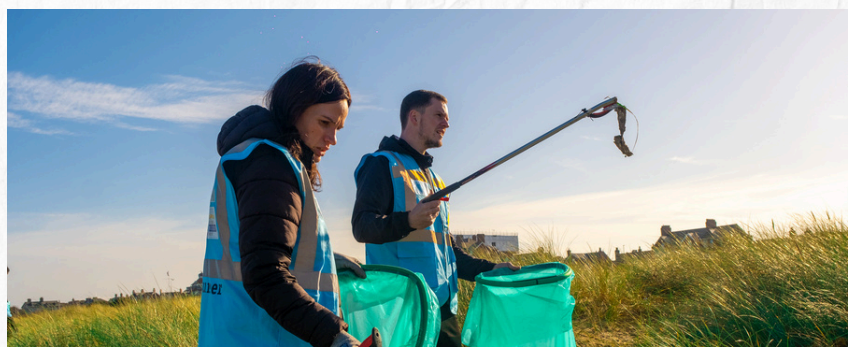
