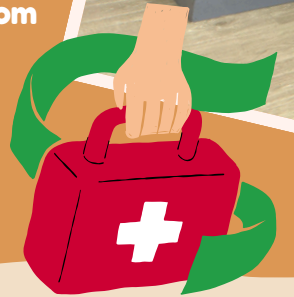


## YOUTH VOICE - DEFIBRILLATOR
