### **Poolfoot Farm**

The football programme allows students to train each day and compete in either the EFL's CEFA, or AoC, league and cup. All students are coached by UEFA and FA qualified coaches with a vast array of experience in the game at various levels. We work with both male and female players individually, and as a team, on their technical and tactical ability whilst developing their understanding of the game.

Both the male and female teams have a specifically designed coaching programme and all have designated coaches to support and motivate them towards their set goals.

- Work Experience As part of your course here you'll be expected to do work experience.
   This is invaluable for anyone wanting to have a career in the sporting industry, and your tutors will act as mentors to find you suitable placements.
- Other sport activities We don't just deliver football throughout the course, and tutors
  have experience in delivering a range of sports at different levels offering the opportunity to do a variety of sports. These sessions may be put in place as part of your
  recovery, but also delivered within your qualification.



## Parent & Guardian Need to Know's

#### How do we get a training kit?

We will ask you to complete a form to order your kit on your interview/enrolment. We ask for a subsidised payment with the CT covering the remainder of the cost.

#### Do we have to wear a training kit?

If students are participating in the football teams, we do expect them to wear the training kit for football specific training sessions and on matchday.

#### Can we apply for a bursary?

Yes, all students have the opportunity to apply for a bursary. Students can get financial help to support them throughout their studies with us.

#### How many hours of training do we do?

- 3 hours of match specific training
- Match day
- 1 hour recovery/other sports

#### What qualification will I come out with?

Depending on your GCSE grades you will be enrolled on either:

- Level 2 BTEC Diploma in Sports Industry Skills (Leading Childrens Sports Activities)
- · Level 3 BTEC Diploma in Sport Coaching & Development
- Level 3 BTEC Extended Diploma in Sport Coaching & Development

#### What are my options after finishing college?

- University either our own Foundation Degree OR other universities
- Potential scholarships to America
- Careers in different sectors of the sports and leisure industry
- Apprenticeship Opportunities

#### Do we get to compete in fixtures?

All students have the chance to represent Fleetwood Town. We currently have 2 male teams and 1 female team playing in the EFL's CEFA league and the AOC Sports college league. We also enter a cup competition for all teams.

As we are based at Poolfoot Farm, home of FTFC 1st team and Academy, we enable students to learn, work and play in an elite environment. Being so close to the professional football club, we can provide excellent work experience opportunities and the chance to work alongside and learn from experienced professionals. Not only do we provide experience, but we also look to develop students into paid work – most notably within the Community Trust as sports coaches.





# **Work Experience**

At Fleetwood Town Community Sports College, our students are provided with the opportunities to enter employment or higher education within the world of sport and leisure. Former students have either successfully applied to go to university to study Sports Coaching or Sports Therapy or have secured full time employment within the sporting sector.

The carefully selected modules within this course will allow students to sample a variety of fields within the sports industry and learn about potential career pathways.

In addition to this, our students will have the opportunity to gain hands-on experience throughout the duration of the course. We feel the work experience on offer at Fleetwood Town provides our students with unique career development opportunities within the sport and leisure industry that cannot be experienced at other colleges.

Through getting to know our students, we are able to tailor work experience and placement opportunities around each individual. This involves regular discussions with each student around their aspirations within their two-year programme, and we ensure that the placements provided to them meet their personal goals.

We have been able to provide our students with a variety of different work placement opportunities with just a few to mention below:

### BTEC Level 2 in Sports Industry Skills (Leading Childrens Sport Activities)

The purpose of the BTEC Level 2 programme is to bridge the gap from leaving secondary education in order for them to be fully equipped to progress onto the BTEC Level 3.

This course allows learners the time to develop skills and prepare them to be able to work in the sport and leisure industry. On the Level 2 programme, you will be given support on all areas of the course, and benefit from small group teaching.

## **Entry Requirements**

You must achieve at least three GCSE's at grade 3 or equivalent

\*Within any of our BTEC courses, if you have not achieved a grade 4 in your maths and English, you will resit these as part of your course. This will not affect you studying, or playing and you will be given a designated teacher to allow you to achieve in these areas.\*
